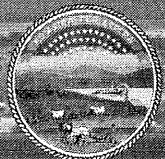

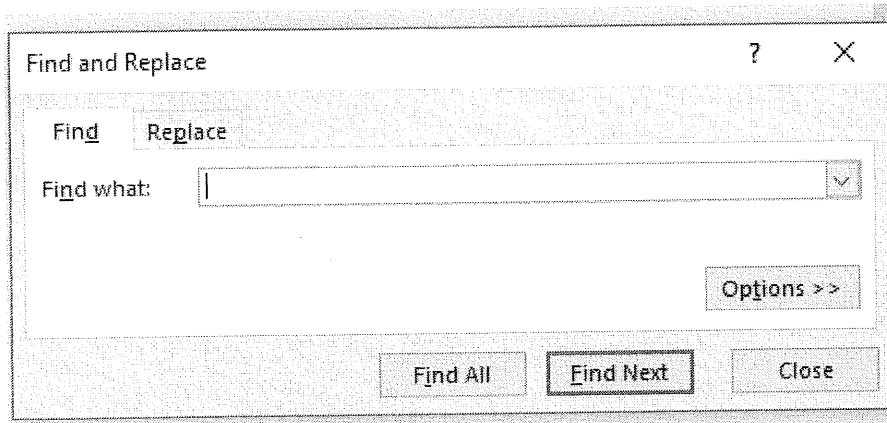

When the excel file downloads you may have to enlarge the columns to see the NPI. Then click on the Find & Sort tab.



Type in the NPI number to do the search. We search for NPI due to the likelihood of physicians with the same name. If the physician is on this list they are in **Good Standing** with Medicare. If you are unable to search successfully for a physician, they are not in **Good Standing** with Medicare.
